





My grandmother, Maria, was born on March 10th, 1938.



My grandma moved from Mexico to Minnesota when she was 18 (eighteen) years old.




She met my grandpa a month after she came to Minnesota.



My grandparents were married on Monday, May 1 (first), 1950 (nineteen fifty).




They had many children – including my mom.




